

GSR031: Introducing Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners & Transmission Service Providers

Key points to note to the Panel

 As GC0159 has been affected by interactions with <u>GC0156</u>, the Chair asked the ESO representative if SQSS would be affected by such interactions. The ESO representative was not aware of any interactions to delay GSR031.

Solution and Workgroup Vote

Solution:

- The objective of this modification is to implement changes to the SQSS to facilitate the introduction of CATOs. The changes, which are non-exhaustive, are made on the assumption that a CATO will be granted a Transmission Licence and will be categorised as an Onshore Transmission Owner. Our initial assessment indicated that this would include introducing the Competitively Appointed Transmission Owner concept to the SQSS Terms and Definitions, in addition to other consequential changes including but not limited to changes to Specifying the Standards that will apply to CATO assets in the respective incumbent TO areas.
- This will be achieved through the proposed high-level changes to the SQSS legal text.

Summary of Workgroup Vote:

The Workgroup concluded unanimously that the Original better facilitated the Applicable Objectives than the Baseline.
