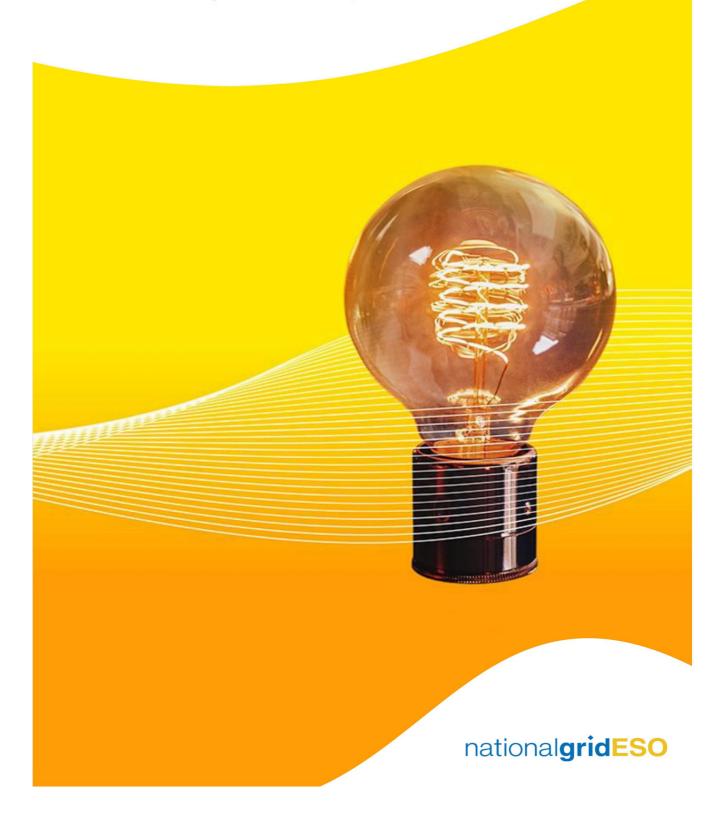





Latest forecast (Summary)	<u>Met Office</u> <u>SEPA</u> <u>Natural</u> <u>Resources</u> <u>Wales</u>	Today: Rain, sleet and snow pushes northwards through Thursday. Snow confined to North Wales, Northern Ireland and northern England, mainly on high ground. Snow turning to freezing rain for north Wales bringing icy stretches. Brighter spells and heavy rain further south. Tonight: Rain and snow continue to track northwards into Scotland overnight but intensities decrease. A widespread frost expected away from coasts in the north but more rain moves in further south.
