Introduction

The original reason codes for disarming and re-arming the new response services Dynamic Containment (DC), Dynamic Moderation (DM) and Dynamic Regulation (DR) were introduced in March 2023.

As you can see there is only a single code for disarming, whereas there are multiple codes for re-arming.

This resulted in some confusion, and there were lots of questions.

The new codes have been developed to be less confusing and more specific.

Original Reason Codes:

DC	Resume Dynamic Containment		
DCL	Resume Dynamic Containment Low		
DCH	Resume Dynamic Containment High		
DM	Resume Dynamic Moderation

DMH	Resume Dynamic Moderation High		
DR	Resume Dynamic Regulation		
DRL	Resume Dynamic Regulation Low		
DRH	Resume Dynamic Regulation High		

What are the new Reason Codes?

The new codes are clear about which service is being disarmed and re-armed, as each variant of each service has its own disarm and re-arm code.

These new reason codes are based on feedback that we received from providers.

If needed 2 instructions can be issued to disarm a full service.

For example to disarm all DR services, instructions with reasons code XRL and XRH would be issued.

This will mean that the following reason codes will be retired from use: DNS, DC, DM, DR

New Reason Codes:

Timeline of Changes to Reason Codes

Mar 2023 IT System (BM) Disarming and re-arming of response goes live in BM Valid EDL Codes

May 2024 Participant testing offered for new reason codes

June 2024 New disarming and re-arming reason codes go-live

Jan 2022 Original disarm and re-arm reason codes are issued

Sep 2023 New disarming and re-arming reason codes are added

Jul-Sep 2024 Unused reason codes will be retired

Participant Testing

What testing will be done?

Short EDL business process integration test will be done which will focus on sending instructions with the 12 reason codes detailed on slide 4

Two outcomes will be tested (as instruction can be either Accepted or Rejected)

Along with these we will do some selective regression of EDL instructions like BOA, MVAR, VOLT etc..
