1. Title of Amendment Proposal

Clarification of STC Party and Party Representative responsibilities

2. Description of the Proposed Amendment

Offshore Transmission Owners (OFTOs) may appoint two persons via an election to the STC Committee as Party Representatives. It is proposed that the elected Party Representatives shall represent the OFTOs collectively and, as appropriate, inform the Committee of the views of all the OFTOs in relation to the functions of the Committee and in particular the amendment of the Code.

National Grid has reviewed references to Party/Parties/Party Representatives within Section B of the STC to ensure that the correct defined term is being utilised since the accession of the OFTOs to the STC. For clarity it is proposed to update a number of references to Party/Parties/Party Representatives.

3. Description of Issue or Defect that this Proposed Amendment seeks to Address

Currently the STC does not define any Party Representative duties. This previously has not been an issue as the onshore Transmission Owner Party Representatives only represent themselves. However, as only two persons can be elected to the STC Committee to represent the Offshore Transmission Owners collectively, there is a requirement to ensure that the role of the OFTO's Party Representatives is to represent the views of all the OFTOs they are acting on behalf of.

Since the accession of the OFTOs to the STC, National Grid has reviewed Section B to ensure that the correct defined terms are being utilised for Party/Parties/Party Representatives. Previously, these terms for transmission companies had been interchangeable as an STC Party (signatories to the Framework Agreement) was also an STC Party Representative. This is no longer the case for OFTOs. Although they will be a signatory to the STC, some may not be appointed as STC Party Representatives. For clarity it is proposed to update a number of references to Party/Parties/Party Representatives.
