## **1. Title of Amendment Proposal**

Timescales for providing Transmission Services as defined in the STC

## **2. Description of the Proposed Amendment**

To define the timescales in which an Offshore Transmission Owner (OFTO) will be expected to provide Transmission Services, in particular,

- the availability of the OFTO to provide services and;
- the maximum time in which an OFTO can be expected to deliver the services

defined in STCP1-1.

## **3. Description of Issue or Defect that Proposed Amendment seeks to Address** *(mandatory field)*

Section C of the STC obliges TOs to provide NGET with Transmission Services which will enable NGET to configure and direct flows through the NETS. The services and processes for delivery are defined in the STCPs. However, for some of the operational services, the STCPs do not state explicitly how these services will be delivered by the TO, in particular,

- to ensure safe and effective operation of the National Electricity Transmission System,
- communications and;
- operational actions needed.

The purpose of this amendment is to avoid any misunderstanding between the SO and TO in regard to the provision of Transmission Services.

## **4. Impact on the STC**

The STC obliges TOs to provide the Transmission Services but is silent on timescales. The intention of this proposal is to amend STCP1-1 and leave the STC unchanged.
