1 Introductions and Apologies for Absence

3726. **Minute 3116: Workplan for Review of STCPs.** It has been identified that a review of some STCPs is required. It is recognised that a number of STCPs will be affected by ITPR, although not all will be affected. Reviews of the STCPs impacted by ITPR will be carried out in line with the ITPR timetable and a document review plan for remaining documents is to be developed. HKW asked the Panel to provide their views on the priority of STCPs for review. KS queried whether the Statement of Works Workgroup being run by ENA has been considered as part of the review schedule. HKW confirmed it hadn't to date and asked KS to send details to LH. The Panel all agreed to send any thoughts regarding priority to LH by Friday 11 December 2015. JL advised that an updated timetable for the ITPR changes had been developed and **LH agreed to circulate this following the Panel meeting**. All changes are scheduled for implementation by August 2016 and therefore it is proposed that by July 2016, the Panel will have approved all changes. It was noted that MO had already

commenced work on the changes to STCP11-1 and that a copy with proposed amendments had been circulated. **KS asked MO for a copy of the revised STCP11-1 to be sent to him**.

PM083: STCP19-5 Update and clarification of process for issuing an Final Section K Notification (FSKN) to prospective OFTOs

3736. At the July 2015 Modification Panel, ML advised that there is an issue regarding whether the proposed wording in the revised STCP accurately reflects the OTSDUW process. ML noted that the relevant part of the process is currently being gone through with Westermost Rough and this may help in establishing a way forward/appropriate wording. At the December 2015 Modification Panel, ML advised that something (possibly a statement of document) is required within the OTSDUW process which demonstrates that the OFTO is sufficiently advanced to

move onto the next state of completion as STCP19-5 does not formally recognise this position currently. ML is working with NGET (Richard Lavender and Mark Baker) to progress this.

PM085: STCP04-3 Power Available Signal

- 3737. AJ presented the Modification Proposal and proposed amendments to STCP 04-3, noting that at the last STC Modification Panel, the Panel were broadly in agreement with the change.
- 3738. MD queried how the generator would provide the signal and AJ confirmed this would be automated. JL asked whether this would be applied retrospectively and AJ advised not, and that it would apply to any plant with a completion date after April 2016. NS reiterated that this is not a new issue and although the change is not necessary since no additional obligations are required, it does add clarity.
- 3739. The Panel approved PM085 and LH will arrange for the formal sign off process to take place.
