Approval of Panel Minutes

The meeting minutes from the Panel on 27 March 2024 were approved and these have been uploaded to our website.

New Urgent Modifications

Two new Modification Proposals were presented to the Panel:

CM095 - Implementing Connections Reform

This modification is looking to enable the timely connection of projects to meet net zero. This proposal introduces new processes and definitions that will update the existing processes and enable projects that are most ready to progress more rapidly to connection. Details of the above modification can be found here.

CM096 - Application of Gate 2 Criteria to existing contracted background

This modification is looking to introduces new processes and definitions that will update the existing processes and enable new applicants with more ready projects to progress more rapidly to connection.

Gate 2 is a key component of the update; however, the size and rate of growth of the connections queue means that significant action is required as soon as possible to reduce the current queue so that viable projects can be connected more quickly and so that the benefits of our proposed Connections Reform model can be delivered earlier. This Modification seeks to address this by applying a project milestone/criteria ('Gate 2') to all existing contracted parties before they are provided with confirmed connection dates and locations. CM086 - Introducing competitively Appointed Transmission Owners & Transmission Service Providers	This modification aims to introduce the concept of Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners (CATOs) to the STC to enable Onshore Network Competition for the design, build and ownership of Onshore Transmission assets.	30 September 2024
CM087 - Introducing Connections Process to facilitate Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners	This modification is concerned with issues around the TO-CATO Connections process to facilitate the introduction of Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners (CATOs) to the STC. This is to enable Onshore Network Competition for the design, build and ownership of Onshore Transmission assets.	30 September 2024

CM094 - Amendment to Bi-annual estimate provisions (Authority send-back)

Panel members confirmed a second recommentation vote was not needed, and the Final Modifications Report could be issued to the Authority.
