• JESG Actions Review

- The Technical Secretary noted the JESG Standing Actions and updates on current actions. The current version of the JESG action log, including any additions from this meeting, is [attached to this Headline Report](#).

• The GB Implementation Plan, John Young and Rob Wilson, National Grid

- John Young talked through the work that NGET have been carrying out to 'package' the modifications required across the GB Codes to implement the EU Codes. He explained that this piece of work is ongoing and further meetings have been planned with the Code Administrators to validate and verify all aspects of the Plan outlined to the JESG membership today.
- One member of the Group questioned whether time had been allocated for Stakeholders to be involved within the process in order to raise alternatives, look at legal text and debate the modifications. This member was assured that as they work with the Code Administrators to evolve the Plan this would be factored into the timescales.
- It was noted by the JESG membership that transparency is the key in the process. It was requested that should an EU Code not have a natural fit within the GB Codes that this was still noted as part of the overall Plan and that it would be recorded as to where the debate and discussions would be happening so Stakeholders could be involved where they wish to be.
- An additional point was raised around the removal as well as insertion of legal text within the GB Codes and whether this had been considered. It was noted that this would be reviewed on a case by case within the respective Workgroup discussions.
- Further points were raised around:
 - .1 Co-ordination of resource across GB Codes when looking at the same defect. All members agreed that this needs to happen to make the process as efficient as possible.
 - .2 When the Plan would be available to Stakeholders. NGET confirmed that this will be published following discussions mid-March with Code Administrators. It will be circulated in the Weekly update on the 31st March 2017 (see Actions Log)
 - .3 Whether something should be submitted to Code Panels (see Action Log)
 - .4 Rooms and organisation of meetings. Energy UK and Elexon offered rooms for use where it would be of use to Industry.
 - .5 Cross Code working. It was noted by a member that the respective Governance processes across the Codes should not be a barrier to working together on issues.

• TERRE, John Young, National Grid

- John Young talked through the slides provided in the pack. He emphasised the importance of Stakeholders feeding into the process and outlined the key dates within the slides for Stakeholders to do so.
- He outlined that there would be a Consultation issued shortly and when it is open that it would be included within the Weekly update.

• AOB

- No AOB was raised at the meeting.
