

Reactive Power Offshore and the Commercial Arrangements 4th May 2011

Consultation Responses



History

- The industry was invited to respond to the Reactive Power Offshore consultation
- Consultation opened 3rd February, closed the 3rd March
- Six responses received
 - Three Vertical Integrated companies (Centrica, EDF Energy and RWE NPower)
 - Two OFTOs companies (Transmission Capital and Thanet OFTO)
 - One engineering service company (Cardiff Power)



Results - Overview

- Question 1 Do you agree with the findings of the comparison between the offshore and onshore generator?
 - Generally Agreed (4) Cardiff Power, Centrica, Transmission Capital, EDF
 - Generally Not Agreed (1) RWE NPower
 - Neural (1) Thanet
- Question 2 Do you believe the commercial arrangements as described in the consultation are appropriate for the offshore regime?
 - Generally Agreed (4) Centrica, Transmission Capital (Generators), Thanet,
 EDF
 - Generally Not Agreed (2) Transmission Capital (OFTOs), RWE NPower
 - Neutral (1) Cardiff Power



Result Overview

- Question 3 Do you believe alternative commercial arrangements should be considered?
 - Yes (3) Cardiff Power (TNUoS rebate), Transmission Capital (MVAr tariff for OFTOs), RWE NPower (DPM for all MVArs or socialised TNUoS)
 - No − (2) Centrica (Generally no), EDF (Generally no),
 - Neutral (1) Thanet
