#### 1 Summary

- 1.1 This document describes the CMP233 Modification Proposal and includes views from one industry member relating to the proposal.
- 1.2 CMP233 was proposed by National Grid Electricity Transmission Plc (the Proposer) and was submitted to the CUSC Modifications Panel (the Panel) for their consideration on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2014. A copy of the Proposal form is provided in Annex 1 of this document. The Panel determined that CMP233 should be considered as Self-Governance and should progress directly to Code-Administrator Consultation for the standard 15 Business Days. A copy of the Self-Governance statement can be found in Annex 2.
- 1.3 CMP233 aims to change CUSC Exhibit F, Use of System Application form, requesting further information from the applicant to ensure National Grid is able to process their application effectively and more efficiently.
- 1.4 The Code Administrator Consultation closed on 19<sup>th</sup> August 2014 and received one response; this can be found in Annex 4, a summary of this response can also be found in Section 7 of this report.
- 1.5 At the CUSC Panel meeting on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2014, the CUSC Panel unanimously agreed that CMP233 better meets Applicable CUSC Objective (a) and therefore should be implemented.
- 1.6 This Final CUSC Modification Report has been prepared in accordance with the terms of the CUSC. An electronic copy can be found on the National Grid website, <a href="http://www2.nationalgrid.com/UK/Industry-information/Electricity-codes/CUSC/Modifications/CMP233/">http://www2.nationalgrid.com/UK/Industry-information/Electricity-codes/CUSC/Modifications/CMP233/</a>, along with the CUSC Modification Proposal form.

#### **National Grid's Opinion**

1.7 National Grid supports the implementation of CMP233 as it better facilitates Applicable CUSC Objective (a) as it improves National Grids processes and ensures efficient discharge of their obligations imposed upon it by the Act and the Transmission Licence.

#### **CUSC Modification Panel's Determination**

1.8 At the meeting of the CUSC Modifications Panel on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2014, the Panel voted unanimously that CMP233 better facilitates Applicable CUSC Objective (a) and therefore should be implemented. Further details on the CUSC Panel vote can be found in Section 6.

#### **Implementation**

1.9 The 15 Working day Self-Governance appeals window commenced on 26<sup>th</sup> September and closes on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014. If no objections are received, the Code Administrator will implement CMP233 10 Working days later on 7 July 2014.

#### 2 Background

- 2.1 Interconnectors and Suppliers applying for use of transmission system are required to complete CUSC Exhibit F (application form for Interconnector and Supplier Use of System applications) and submit to National Grid. The existing application form for Interconnector and Supplier Use of System applications does not provide National Grid with all the relevant information required to process applications effectively and efficiently.
- 2.2 After receiving an application, National Grid requests further information from the applicant via email. If this information could be provided initially, National Grid would be able to process the application as soon as they receive the initial application.

#### 3 Modification Proposal

- 3.1 CMP233 aims to make changes to the CUSC Exhibit F to ensure that it captures all the required information in the initial application to enable National Grid to process the application effectively.
- 3.2 The changes within the application form include a requirement for the applicant to provide;
  - A UK address (for those registered outside the UK)
  - A VAT number (if applicable)
  - Contact details for invoices
- 3.3 The application form will also be amended to ensure that for Supplier Use of System Applications, their choice of security provision is captured to ensure National Grid can set up the right facilities for security provisions in a timely manner.
- 3.4 Additional guidance will also be provided within Section A of the form to provide clarity on the effective date of the application being from the receipt of the application fee as set out in the Statement of Use of System Charges. Following this effective date, National Grid will have 28 days to make an offer to the customer as set out in CUSC Section 3.7.2.

#### 4 Implementation and Transition

4.1 As CMP233 was approved by the CUSC Panel, a 15 day appeals window commenced on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2014 and will close on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014. Subject to any appeals, CMP233 will be implemented 10 Working days later on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2014.


