Explanation and justification of DX mod

- Data Exchange Modification proposal driven by Title II of SOGL – Article 40 – 53
- Primarily comprised of 2 parts;
 - Direct* data exchange requirements taken from SOGL (largely articles 41-53)
 - However; within these requirements there is large scope for flexibility i.e. to meet System needs inline with current framework
 - Changes arising from the 'All TSO' proposal on Key
 Organisational Requirements, Roles & responsibilities relating
 to Data Exchange (KORRR)

^{*}Note some sections of DX have dependencies on other parts of SOGL


Complex timeline....

As stated in article 192 of SOGL:

"Articles 41 to 53 shall apply 18 months after the entry into force of this Regulation"

- Therefore DX title overall applies form 14/3/2019
- However this time period includes regulatory approval period of up to 6 months: Article 6:(4)(b) & (9)
- The KORRR is required 6 months after EIF: 14/3/2018
 - Then also has 6 months regulatory approval period
 - Before applying along with the rest of DX Title 18m after EIF

In Summary

- Now is the appropriate time to raise mode;
 - KORRR draft becomes publically available for assessment
 - Still sufficient time to develop and implement mod
 - Approval can be considered in parallel (with KORRR) by Ofgem
- Cannot wait until KORRR is finalised as does not leave sufficient time
- Mod proposal is 'work in progress' until we have full assessment of KORRR

Parallel working with alongside ENC Methodology/proposal development, whilst more complex, is necessary
